




## Using an Online Brainstorming Application to Begin Your Personal Project Essay and Automatically Create your Table of Contents



1) Goto [www.mindmeister.com](http://www.mindmeister.com) and join the website for free. You are able to produce five free mind-maps, which will be more than enough for your Personal Project Presentation.





2) Create a new Mind-map – by clicking the button.




3) Begin creating your mind-map, it is as easy as double clicking to add a node. Click and drag the node to move it to a different parent subject.

4) Don't worry about saving as it does this automatically... :) ~










9) When you have completed your mind-map – click on the Export Button.


10) Choose Document Outline as the format for export



11) Save to Disk – hopefully to your desktop

13) Open your document in MS Word, you might need to Control Click if on a MAC (right click for Windows) and open with MS Word.


14) Notice that all the information on the mind-map has been imported including links, and levels of nodes and parents.

14) Click at the top of your document and click on the Insert menu and Index and Tables option.


15) Choose ToC –Tables of Contents, and a style of your choice

16) MS Word will automatically create a ToC at the top of your document, with all node titles according to the level you chose. Show 3 levels - is about right.




17) If you change from Print Layout View to Outline View you will see the different levels of your document text – from titles to body text.



18) Note the + signs designate a parent title, and the minus signs show a level below. If some of your tiles are in the wrong order just copy and paste them where you would like them to go as I a normal document.


But you will have to update your ToC.

19) To update your ToC, control click on it (right click for Windows) and select update field.

20) Then choose update entire table as shown in the dialogue box.






21) To add BODY TEXT e.g. your content to your essay return to the Outline View. Choose where you would like to enter the text e.g. under the Investigate title as below and begin typing.

22) After you have entered the text – select it and click on the double blue arrow and demote to BODY TEXT.

23) Your text should look like this.

23) Return to Print Layout view and you will see your text within your main part of the essay, but because it is only BODY TEXT it will not appear in your ToC.

24) That is about it...have a play around with the Outline styles, and demoting and promoting the text within the Outline view so that it links within your ToC.

**FINAL HINT** – Remember you can share your mind-map with other students, or more importantly your Personal Project Advisor/ Teacher.
